Lake Dallas City Council Agenda Items

February 25, Regular Meeting

- December 2020 Financial Report - The City Charter requires a monthly report from the City Manager on the expenditures and accruals for the preceding month and for the fiscal year-to-date (Strategic Goal 4, Objective 4.2).
- Take appropriate action on an Ordinance approving a Zoning Change request for .224 acres of land being located at Block 1, Lot 7, Providence Addition, and being located in the City of Lake Dallas, Denton County, Texas; generally located at the northwest corner of Betchan Street and Main Street from Retail (C-1) to Planned Development Residential R-1-6000 providing for development of three (3) residential homes (Z-2020-005).
- Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding the City's activities in response to the recent inclement weather incident from February 20 – 26, 2021.
- Consider and Act on a Resolution authorizing the negotiation and execution of a professional services agreement with The Lion Strategy Group, LLC for organization training and policy implementation of the City of Lake Dallas (Strategic Goal 4, Objective 4.3).

March 11, Regular Meeting

- Receive the Quarterly Investment Report (Strategic Goal 4, Objective 4.2).
- Consider a resolution awarding a contract for foundation repairs at City Hall (Strategic Goal 4, Objective 4.5).
- Consider a resolution authorizing a contract with Prestige General Contracting, LLC for construction repairs at the Fire Station building.
- Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding amendments to the Code of Ordinances relating to Scenic City review criteria (Strategic Goal 1, Objective 1.6, and Strategic Goal 2, Objective 2.2).
- Consider a resolution supporting proposed legislation to the Street Repair and Maintenance Sales Tax, which is collected in the City.

- Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding Chapter 22 revisions proposed by the Rental Registration Program Committee (Strategic Goal 1, Objective 1.6).
- Consider a resolution allowing the purchase of a portable storage unit for City Hall.
- Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding core values for the organization (Strategic Goal 4, Objective 4.1).
- Consider a resolution to enter an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Denton County for street repairs of Shady Shores Road north of Swisher Road (Strategic Goal 5, Objective 5.2, and Strategic Goal 4, Objective 4.2).
