 - a) Julie Chapman was introduced by Earl Berner as the new Special Events Coordinator for the City of Lake Dallas.
 - b) Minutes from the April 19, 2010 meeting were approved.
 - c) A report on the status of the Fourth of July celebration plans was given by Julie Chapman including discussion on the contests and parade. Specifics on the Patriotic Person Costume Contest were outlined which will entail two categories of best dressed as 'Lady Liberty' and 'Uncle Sam'. Board members Joe Canales and James Moore volunteered to judge the contest in which the respective winners receive \$50. The contest will be held at 2 PM on Saturday, July 3rd.

The board inquired about a 'rain out date' for the event which Mr. Berner said there would be none. In addition, Joe Canales would like the event videotaped and footage used to promote the events via YouTube. It was suggested board member John Witter should be asked to record footage.

 - d) The Great American Clean Up event held on Saturday, May 15th in partnership with Keep Hickory Creek Beautiful was a successful. More than 80 vouchers were applied for at the City of Lake Dallas for Hazardous Waste and 50 volunteers assisted with clean-up in both respective towns. A report is due to Keep Texas Beautiful by June 11, 2010.

5. New Agenda Items: Planters for the Thousand Oaks addition are in need of restoration. Joe Canales is willing to spearhead a group and will draw up a scope of project for the City.
