

**How?**   **Who?**   **What?**   **When?**   **Where?**   **Why?**  
*¿Cómo?*   *¿Quién?*   *¿Qué?*   *¿Cuándo?*   *¿Dónde?*   *¿Por qué?*

To ask questions with a question word, the same rules are used as for a yes/no question (see beginner grammar for details).

*Para hacer preguntas con una palabra de pregunta, se utilizan las mismas reglas que para una pregunta sí/no. (consulte gramática para principiantes para obtener más información)*

The question word goes at the start of the sentence. Then 'to be' or 'to do'. Then the subject.  
*La palabra pregunta va al comienzo de la oración. Entonces 'ser' o 'hacer'. Luego el tema.*

Examples:

**How** are you? I'm fine. **How** do you spell 'cat'? You spell 'cat' C-A-T.

**Who** am I? I'm Mary Smith. I'm a teacher.

**What** does she do? She's a teacher. **What** is she doing? She's teaching.

**When** does he work? He works on Mondays and Wednesdays from one o'clock to six.

**Where** do they work? They work at the office building on Main Street.

**Why** do you like cats? I like cats **because** they are cute and cuddly.
