



On March 25, 2021, The Lake Dallas City Council held a discussion to consider suspension of various provisions in Chapter 80 – Signs of the Lake Dallas Code of Ordinances as local businesses recover from COVID-19.

- Permitting
 - A permit application is still required for all permanent signage.
 - A permit can be found [online](#), or picked up from City Hall.
 - **Permit fees waived:**
 - Provided there is no electrical component to the sign (L.E.D.) the permit fee is waived.
 - Permits with an electrical component will be charged; however, it will be at a reduced rate.
- Temporary Signage -
 - Banners, wind signs, “H-frame” signs and other temporary signage that is typically prohibited will be allowed.
 - Signs must remain out of the right-of-way for visibility reasons.
 - Signs advertising places of business may not be placed on City Property.
 - The right-of-way is the surface of, and the space above and below, any street, road, highway, or other easement held by the City for management of utilities and other functions.
 - For reference, right-of-ways often include electrical boxes, telephone poles, gas meters and other utility functions.
- Temporary Suspensions to these provisions in Chapter 80 – Signs will be in place through the end of the calendar year (December 31, 2021).
